NEW YORK -- New York City Mayor Eric Adams [has been indicted following a federal investigation](#).

The U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York announced [the specific charges](#) Thursday.

Earlier, federal agents could be seen parked outside the mayor's home at Gracie Mansion.

"Federal agents appeared this morning at Gracie Mansion in an effort to create a spectacle (again) and take Mayor Adams phone (again). He has not been arrested and looks forward to his day in court," Adams' attorney Alex Spiro said in a statement. "They send a dozen agents to pick up a phone when we would have happily turned it in."

The indictment comes [on the heels of several investigations](#) involving the mayor [and members of his administration](#). The various probes have been [playing out over the course of months](#), starting in [November 2023](#), and heated up with a flurry of subpoenas in recent weeks.
