NEW YORK -- New York City Mayor Eric Adams <u>has been indicted following a federal investigation</u>.

The U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York announced <u>the specific charges</u> Thursday.

Earlier, federal agents could be seen parked outside the mayor's home at Gracie Mansion.

"Federal agents appeared this morning at Gracie Mansion in an effort to create a spectacle (again) and take Mayor Adams phone (again). He has not been arrested and looks forward to his day in court," Adams' attorney Alex Spiro said in a statement. "They send a dozen agents to pick up a phone when we would have happily turned it in."

The indictment comes <u>on the heels of several investigations</u> involving the mayor <u>and members of his administration</u>. The various probes have been <u>playing out over the course of months</u>, starting in <u>November 2023</u>, and heated up with a flurry of subpoenas in recent weeks.
